

# GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL OF ZAMBIA

(The Nurses and Midwives Act No. 31 of 1997)

## REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NURSES AND MIDWIVES TRAINED OUTSIDE ZAMBIA

The G.N.C. will register nurses trained outside Zambia. The following requirements should be met:

- Basic qualification as Registered/Enrolled Nurses
- Official transcripts of training from schools of nursing/midwifery sent directly to the G.N.C.
- Completed registration application forms obtained from the Council
- Certified copies of academic and professional certificates
- Recommendations from two (2) previous immediate supervisors
- Curriculum Vitae
- Entry permit
- Current verification of registration with the country of training
- Three passport size photographs
- Payment of **non refundable** application/registration fee determined by the Council – currently K1,000,000.00
- Payment of **non refundable** examination/interview fee determined by the Council – currently K1,000,000.00
- Passing of registration examination set by the GNC
- Proof that the applicant has sufficient knowledge of the English language

**Note: For nurses and midwives with basic qualification (EN or RN) obtained in Zambia, both registration and interview fee will apply but they will not be required to sit for an examination**
